## **AMEC Scholarship Application**

### **Overview**

Morris Brown College has agreed to create a \$1.5 million dollar scholarship opportunity for AME members worldwide. This scholarship will cover tuition only, which is currently \$8500 per year. Students are responsible for fees, housing, meal services, etc. Five students are selected via a committee selection process per academic year.

### **Morris Brown College APPLICATION PROCESS**

#### **Scholarship applicant must:**

- be high school graduating senior, transfer student or currently enrolled at Morris Brown College who is a member of the AME Church (includes male and female students)
- have a minimum GPA of 2.5 (on a 4.0 scale) and submit an official school transcript; the transcript must cite the applicant's cumulative grade point average
- must maintain a minimum of 2.5 (on a 4.0 scale) while attending Morris Brown at the end of each semester
- submit a typed essay.

**Topic: Based on financial need, describe how winning this scholarship would impact your future plans.**

- submit (1) signed letter of recommendation from school (teacher--former or present, counselors, principals, professors, etc.)
- submit (1) letter of recommendation from the student's local AME church
- submit (1) signed letter of recommendation from a representative of a non-school related community service or organization that the applicant participated in; letter must be on the organization's letterhead; persons writing letter of recommendation should specify relationship or capacity in which they know or have observed the applicant and SIGN the letter

**NOTE: Unsigned letters of recommendation will not be accepted; therefore, the application package will be deemed incomplete and will not be considered.**
